Don't forget that we have one more shoot to go here at Outlaw Camp this year. Our regular **"Fun Fifth Saturday"** shoot will be **December 29th**. This is just a regular cowboy shoot and in addition to our usual targets we try to make use of our reactive targets, rifle and pistol knockdowns, swinging pendulums, moving buffalo, flying bobcat and even some clay pigeons on occasion. We keep score but we really don't hold you to a category. If you would like to shoot a couple of stages gunfighter, duelist, double duelist or whatever, we encourage you to do so. This is a good time to try something new, or shoot your regular category, **just be safe!** We have been known to throw in a lot of different things but they will always be 'fun'. Bring plenty of ammo!

We want to welcome Lefty Forty-Five AKA James Thomas, who came up to try cowboy action shooting for the very first time, and left a new member of Outlaw Camp. Welcome also to Teeshot and Diamond Darlin AKA Ronnie and Sharon Beggs, who came up to shoot with us.

Our second encounter with the ACES scoring system was mixed. We printed the scores and had them on the table immediately after the shoot but very few seemed interested enough to come in and check the results. There are still a few technical kinks to work out but we are sending them out as produced by that program. Let me know what you think.

The overcast skies always seem to help scores as the lighting is more even. This seems to be the case at this shoot--this month we had four shooters with no misses and **three with a clean match. Mustang Moore, Nickel Bill, Doc Fillem.** Sundown Duke had no misses, however he had a little trouble with the shooting order on one stage. Other clean stages were shot by Ozark Outlaw, Mo Brian, Arkansas Drifter, Sundown Duke, Quick Trigger, Ozark Red, Tombstone Shadow with five; Pepper Pete, Lefty Ed, Missouri Plowboy, Dingus Dan Legree, Rattler Joe with four; Outrider, Millican, Arkansas Harper, Teeshot, Boomer Bob, Grande Gringo with three; Stumpman, Deacon Adams, Short Tree, Red River Ralph, Diamond Darlin, and Lefty Forty-Five with two; and Sweet Water Sue, Mustang Toni, Windslinger, Arkansas Bell and Strongbox with one. Ozark Red hit everything she shot at, she just had a split case that locked up her rifle and cost her six misses.

We are tentatively planning to give the awards for 2012 on January 12 at our regular shoot. Remember, they are based on your best six scores in the same category. We will have coffee and hot cider with doughnuts and sweet rolls etc. starting about 9:30, with the shoot to follow.

Dues are due and payable for 2013- still \$25.00 per year for immediate family.

The holiday season is here and Thanksgiving is already past. Red and I always enjoy this time of year as an opportunity to put a little special emphasis on family ties and traditions. We hope you, too, are in the midst of a great Holiday season!
