Some shooters go to extra trouble to mark their brass so it can be identified, and are understandably a little upset when they find it has disappeared when they try to find it after the shooting is over. If you are picking up brass and find some that is not your caliber or not marked as yours, please, place it on the unloading table at that stage so it may be found by it's owner.

There is a lot of work to do to get ready for another great "Mayhem on the Mountain" and we will need your help and support. Get those entries in!
