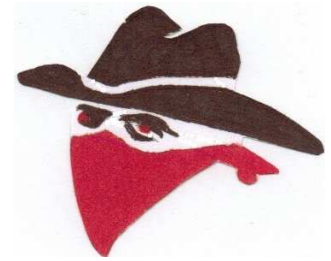


Outlaw Camp Bulletin

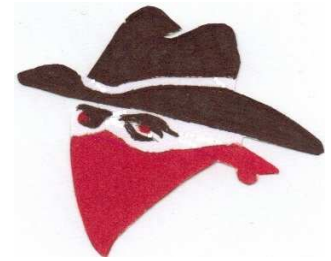

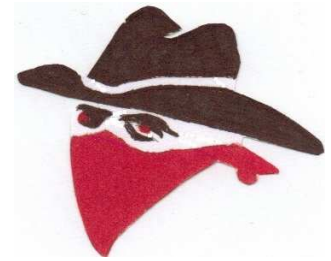

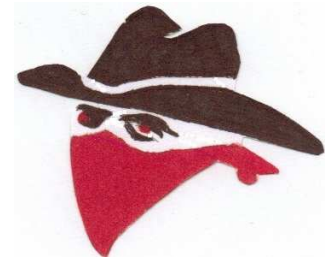
