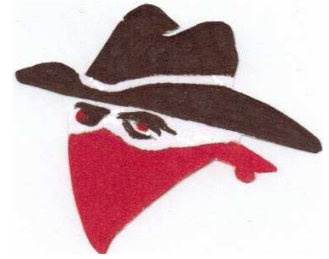


# Outlaw Camp Bulletin

You can send money to [mawbaron@yahoo.com](mailto:mawbaron@yahoo.com) using PayPal, making a note of what it's for, and then I can send the Posse Pics

to you. That would be a \$10 minimum to cover at least one 5x7 printed and shipped. \$5 for each additional 5x7 to go in the same shipment.

Or you may order online yourself and save some money. Either way, use the website I set up to see the photos and choose what you want. The link works best on a laptop or a PC instead of phone: <https://www.markwill.com/photography>

Posse Pics are available in color, black and white, and sepia tone. The ladies' action shots are a little light in total number, and for that I can only apologize and move on. Look at the Candid's, too, for a few more pictures that didn't really fit a category.

**Example of How an Online Order Will Save You Money:** Because of how FotoMoto works, you will pay about \$7.98 for one 5x7, shipped. For two 5x7's, it will be about \$11.99 shipped. The optimal printing size is 5x7, and they are priced at \$5. You may order larger if you like. The quality should hold up pretty well unless you go crazy with it. After you click on a photo, you will have the option to Buy Print, Buy Card, Download, or Send Free E-Card.
