The Cowboy Action shooting group previously known as 'True Grit' has merged with Outlaw Camp. This has resulted in some changes here at Outlaw Camp. Since those shooters historically shot on the fourth weekend each month, we will continue that tradition by shooting here on the fourth Saturday in addition to our regular shoot days of the second and fifth Saturdays. The dues structure has also changed. Dues will continue to be \$25.00 per year for those shooters wishing to shoot on the second and fifth Saturdays. Dues will be \$20.00 for those who wish to shoot on the fourth Saturday schedule. For those who wish to shoot the second, fourth and fifth Saturdays dues will be \$45.00 per year. Shoot fees for each group will be \$10.00 for members and \$15.00 for those who are not members. We hope this transition goes smoothly and will be beneficial to all. During this transition period things will be in a state of flux so bear with us. Our first Fourth Saturday shoot in 2015 proved to be a really nice day and we had 20 shooters so we are off to a good start. Two shooters had clean matches, believe it or not they were Ozark Red and Ozark Outlaw. (First time for Red to clean her own range.)

Our annual awards for Outlaw Camp will continue to be your best six shoots shot in the same category on the regular second Saturday shoots. Not sure yet what the awards will be for the group shooting Outlaw Camp the fourth Saturday.
