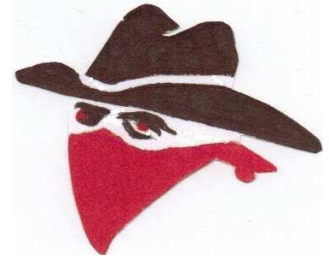


Outlaw Camp Bulletin
