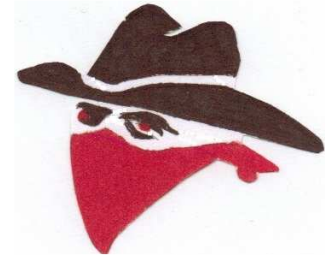


Outlaw Camp Bulletin

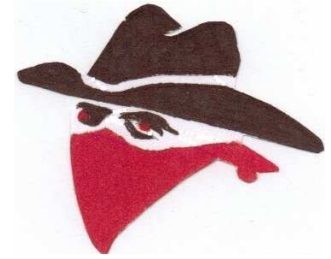

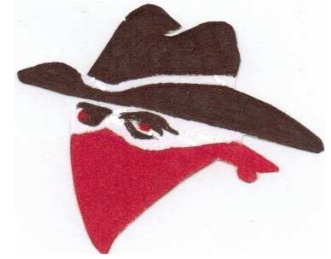
